# In order to help you succeed...

1. You will have a subject teacher and member of support staff (TLA) to support you all day, every day in your subject lessons.
2. You will be based in one room for the majority of your lessons (except Science, ICT, Technology, PE and Performing Arts) There is less movement around school and less disruption because of this.
3. There is a mentoring programme with Post 16 students if required.
4. You will have a Director to help you as and when required.
5. There is a wide range of after school clubs to join.
6. There are numerous trips throughout the year e.g. Houses of Parliament, the Bank of England and Science Museum.

# The vital role of parents

1. Ensure that your child has the appropriate uniform each and every day – shoes, tie, blazer, white shirt.
2. Ensure that your child has the appropriate P.E. kit bought from the College – ask in Reception for an order form.
3. Make sure that your child is on time for College - we start registration at 8.45am. Aim to be in College from 8.30.
4. Attend College each and every day unless you have a very good reason for being off. You do not learn anything if you are off!
5. Remind your child about showing respect and tolerance towards their peers and all members of staff.
6. Research shows the improvements children make when they are supported by their parents.

## HEWENS COLLEGE MOBILE PHONE POLICY

If mobile devices, including MP3/4 players and Smart watches, are seen, heard or is being used by a student during the college day, over the course of a term, the following shall apply:

### **Confiscation for the FIRST time**

The phone or similar personal mobile device will be confiscated for the day. This will be collected at the end of the day from the Principal.



### **Confiscation for the SECOND time**

The phone or similar personal mobile device will be confiscated. Parents/Guardians/Carers will collect the device at an agreed time with SLT/Principal.



### **Confiscation for the THIRD time**

The phone or similar personal mobile device will be confiscated for one week. Parents/Guardians/Carers will collect the device at an agreed time with SLT/Principal.



### **Confiscation for the FOURTH time**

The phone or similar personal mobile device will be confiscated for the remainder of the academic term.
