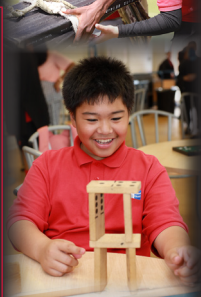
As part of The Rosedale Hewens Academy Trust, we are committed to creating a learning environment where every student can make good progress and fulfil their own ambitions, whatever they may be.
