This will include a formal talk which will provide you with a clear insight as to how Key Stage 4 study is organised and structured, the opportunity to speak to staff about the range of courses available as well as the process of choosing options, and finally, subject area displays providing all the relevant information needed for each student to make an informed decision about their future. Accordingly, students of the MS and HA Alliance, and their families are asked to arrive promptly at 5:30pm to gather information and discuss options with staff, prior to the formal talk at 6:00pm. Students of the TP, EL and AC Alliance, and their families are invited to attend from 6:30pm to view displays and speak with subject teachers, before the talk which begins at 7:00pm.
