Group A Streptococcus Information

We have been asked to pass on the following information regarding Group A streptococcus (Strep A). In most cases the common infections caused by Group A streptococcus are mild. They include sore throat, often referred to as strep throat, mild fever, and minor skin infections.

In very rare cases, this infection can be more serious and cause invasive disease. While the risk is low, it is important to be aware of the signs and symptoms.

These are: Very high fever, Severe muscle aches, Localised muscle pain and unexplained diarrhoea or vomiting.

The UKHSA has advised that there were no reasons for any changes to the school routine and no reason for children to be kept at home if they are well.
