Re: Change of specification for Level 2 Engineering, affecting current Year 9 and 10 students

The examination board Pearson wrote to schools this term to confirm that the current BTEC Level 2 in Engineering is being withdrawn after this summer's examinations. This affects students currently in Year 9 and 10. Those in Year 11 are **not** affected.

The replacement course will be the OCR Cambridge National in Engineering Design.

The good news is that all student work to date can be transferred to this new specification, as the content overlaps with the outgoing BTEC course. The course has the same qualification outcomes and grading as the outgoing BTEC, which is the equivalent to GCSE.

We will be updating our curriculum maps on the websites for Years 9 and 10 to reflect these changes.
