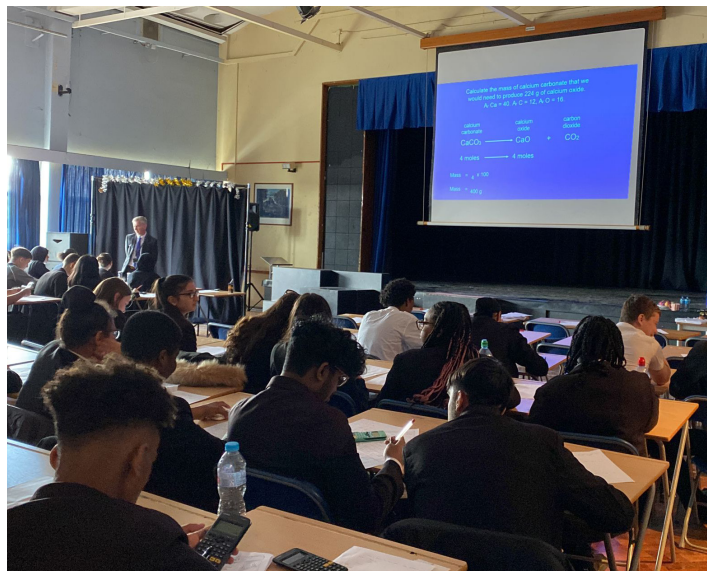

If students do need to have any such devices with them, they must hand them to the invigilation staff at the start of each examination.
