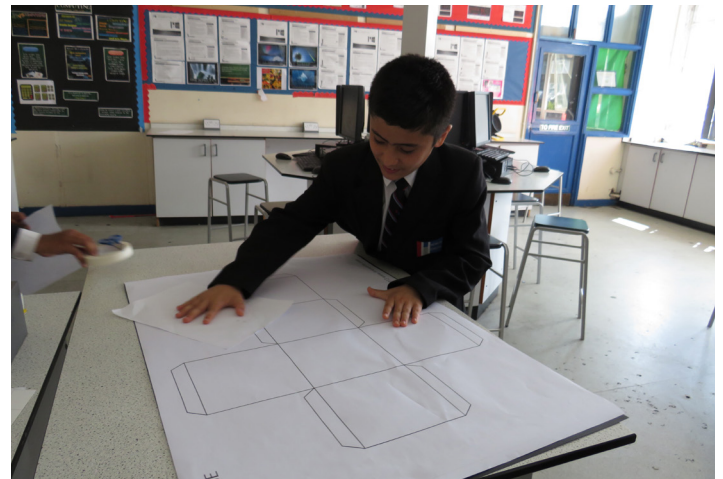


Alliance Challenge
