### ENTRY & RECRUITMENT

Applicants must meet the specific entry criteria for their chosen course, whether vocational qualifications or A Levels. Academic entry requirements are set and assessed by Hewens College in line with qualification guidelines and progression pathways.

In addition to meeting the academic requirements, applicants will be required to attend a football trial as part of the recruitment process.
