## HEWENS COLLEGE CELEBRATE RESULTS DAY

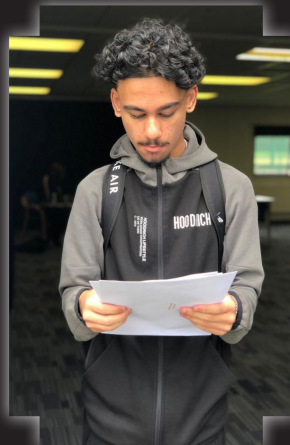
